Made-to-measure is an improved form of made-to-order, allowing for many more adjustments on fit than possible with made-to-order. A final fitting is performed upon delivery to further refine the fit.

Orders can be placed in store all year round. Ring Jacket's trunk show team also visits The Armoury to meet customers four times a year.

Orazio Luciano is also available made-to-measure, building a custom garment using a combination of fitting garments and additional body measurements. A large variety of cloth is available to choose from and additional details may also be specified. Orders can be placed with The Armoury staff in store all year round and we maintain our own archive of special cloth available for purchase as Orazio Luciano garments



Liverano

2 Piece Suit – HKD 54,000 / USD 7,000 +
Liverano, the tailoring house of Antonio Liverano, represents the best of Florentine tailoring, a style exclusive to the region. Florentine jackets feature a slanted side dart instead of a front dart, allowing for a subtly shaped jacket that is crisp and clean in appearance. Antonio travels to The Armoury three times a year with one of the most respected selections of vintage and new cloth in Italy as well as more than a half century of experience. Liverano garments are fully bespoke and handmade.

Carmina

HKD 4,250 / USD 550 +

Carmina, from Mallorca, Spain, is a traditional Goodyear welted shoemaking operation run by the Albaladejo family, shoemakers for four generations. Shoes are constructed in the traditional English manner, using the techniques of Northampton to construct long-lasting shoes in an elegant, Spanish style. The Armoury stocks a variety of lasts and models, from an elegant chisel toe for our oxford models, to a rakish almond toe for our loafers.



Carmina

HKD 5,525 / USD 715 +

Carmina, is also available made-to-order, allowing customers to choose last, leather, sole and other details. It is an excellent choice for those who have found their favourite last and wish to have a unique combination of model and details made for them.



Saint Crispin's

HKD 13,500 / USD 1,650 +

Saint Crispin's, is also available Made-to-Measure, using a system of "last modification." During the construction of a shoe, Saint Crispin's is capable of modifying the last of the shoe, allowing for a variety of changes in instep, heel, toes and arch. They are also capable of producing a fitting shoe for checking adjustments. It is a result comparable to bespoke at a fraction of the price.



Koji Suzuki

HKD 35,000 / USD 4,500 +

Koji Suzuki, one of the finest shoemakers of his generation, trained under Roberto Ugolini in Florence before returning to his native Kobe, Japan and setting up his atelier. Frequently featured in print and television, he represents Japanese attention to detail married with classic Italian style. His greatest strength lies in his understanding of proportion, never allowing gimmickry to get in the way of a perfectly balanced design for an individual customer. Suzuki-san visits our store three times a year and a bespoke order requires multiple fittings.



Saint Crispin's

HKD 13,500 / USD 1,650 +

Saint Crispin's, from Vienna, Austria, is a handmade shoe that is peerless in the ready-to-wear world. It is made to the standards of a bespoke shoe but in standard sizing, available for immediate purchase. The shoes are hand welted rather than Goodyear welted by machine and they feature a firm, tight waist for unparalleled arch support and comfort. All our ready-to-wear shoes are also made with steel toe taps, significantly prolonging the life of an already sturdy shoe. The style is classic European and some of the finest shoes available in the market.





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
